AWARDS FORMAT

- 1 Nominations called for on 30 November 2005
- 2 Closing date for entries is 31 January 2006
- 3 Regional offices select a winner in each award category; announced on 27 February 2006
- 4 All category winners from each region will then be nominated for the Global Award
- 5 ICC judging panel will then select a global winner from the 5 regional nominations in each of the categories; announced on 30 March 2006

AWARD CATEGORIES & GREAT PRIZES

Nominations are called for in the following categories:

Best Overall Cricket Development Program

Relates to the following areas - good governance and management; and outstanding cricket operations and development.

US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment

Best Women's Cricket Initiative

Relates to any women's cricket initiative/activity such as competitions, school programs, training courses, junior or senior clinics, awareness programs etc.

US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment

Photo of the Year

A photo that captures the essence of cricket development in action. Photos can be originals, copies of originals or high quality j-pegs.

US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment

Best Spirit of Cricket Initiative

Relates to an initiative, activity or event that encapsulates the true 'Spirit of Cricket' meaning. *US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment*

Volunteer of the Year

Relates to volunteers who have made a significant contribution to cricket development in the previous 12 months. *US \$500 voucher for Kookaburra equipment*

Best Junior Cricket Initiative

Relates to any junior cricket initiative/activity such as school programs, junior competitions or junior clinics. *Flicx Gemini Bowling Machine*

Best Cricket Promotional Program

Relates to any cricket promotional initiative/activity such as websites, media coverage etc. *US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment*

UNAIDS Award

Relates to work that has directly contributed to addressing HIV/AIDS issues/awareness. *US \$1000 voucher for Kookaburra equipment*

Lifetime Service Award

Relates to individuals who have provided a minimum of 10 years service to cricket development. (Due to the nature of the award, it will be awarded sporadically.) *US \$500 voucher for Kookaburra equipment*
